

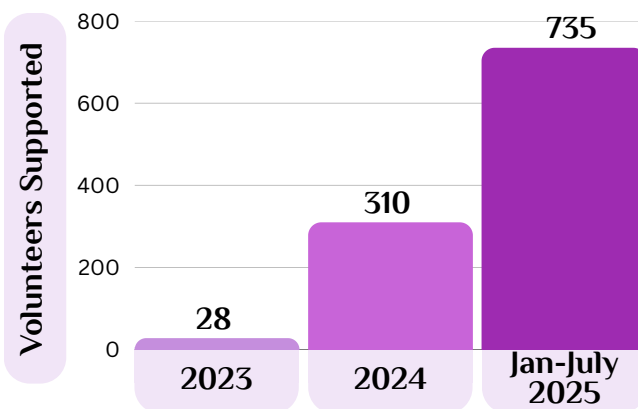


Formed as a 501c(3) in 2023, RPCVnexus has provided 1,000+ across the Peace Corps Community with career support, resources, and a professional network as all consider work and education opportunities along the windy path of one's career.

Through 2024, we reviewed 200+ résumés and hosted 300+ participants during career events.

We reached those same numbers in the first 6 months of 2025 because we had the right systems in place to meet the job loss spikes in February as jobs were lost and the market shifted.

Supporting the Surging Need

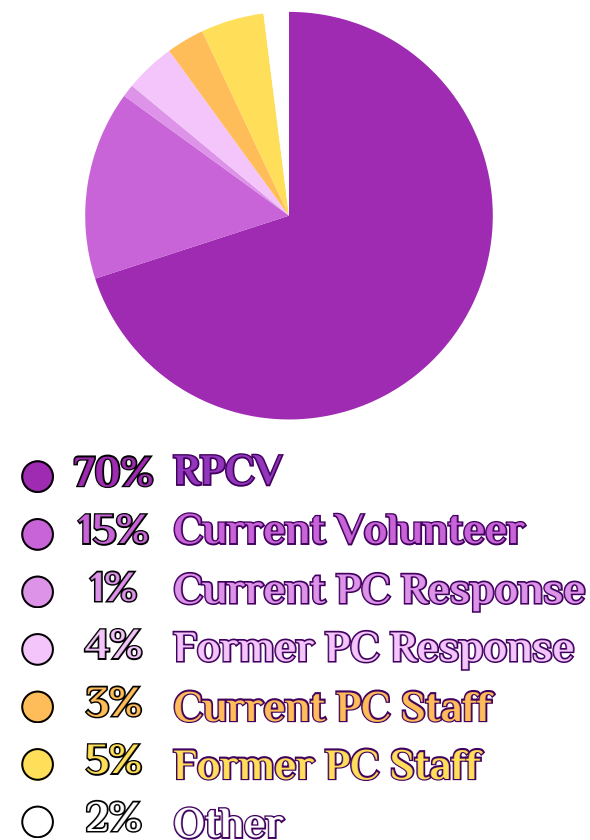


We accomplished this jump by bringing together those across the Peace Corps Professional Network to review résumés, write articles, speak on panels, and more.
